#### What's been happening in your area?

##### Ward Priorities

Bow West Ward Panel which is made up of residents and stake holders, decided that the local Safer Neighbourhood Team should prioritise the following 3 issues:

- 1) **Benworth Street:** drug users loitering waiting to pick up drugs and causing anti social behaviour.
- 2) **Morgan Street:** Anti social behaviour and drug activity.
- 3) **Mile End Rd/Bow Rd:** Retail crime and robbery.

Bow West Safer Neighbourhood team recently assisted Mile End Safer Neighbourhood Team in executing a section 23 Misuse Drugs Act Warrant in Lulsgate Mews. The address was noted by residents as being the centre of regular drug activity and anti social behaviour. The main subject concerned was linked to a previous incident where by they were chased by others whom were armed with knives. Neighbourhood officers in partnership with other agencies collated intelligence to obtain a warrant and force entry at the address. Police found a substantial amount of class B drugs and arrested one male for possession with intent to supply.
